**Patients who have Dental Insurance coverage that pays the office:**

All charges incurred are the responsibility of the patient or their guarantor, NOT the Insurance Company. We must emphasize that as your Dental Care Provider, our relationship is with you, not your insurance company. Our office does not guarantee that your Insurance Company will assist with payment for dental treatment. If your claim is not paid in 60 days, denied, or paid at a lesser amount, you will be responsible for paying the full amount.

We recommend treatment based on our patient's dental needs, not based on Insurance coverage. We estimate what the insurance will pay based on information that they have provided us. What the insurance actually pays will be determined when they process the claim. The estimated patient's portion is due and payable at the start of treatment and if the insurance pays less than estimated, we will bill the remainder to the patient or guarantor.

**Please note:**

Redford Dental Group requires payment at the beginning of your treatment. If you choose to discontinue care before treatment is complete, you will receive a refund less the cost of care received. A fee of \$50.00 is charged for patients who miss or cancel within 48-hour notice. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask.
